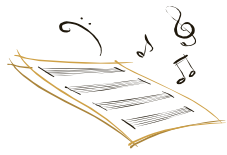

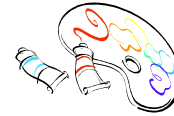
Children's Music

The Graded Choir Ministry provides children age 3 through 5th grade with the opportunity to grow spiritually and musically. All music is chosen with the goal of leading children to a growing faith in Jesus Christ. The music they sing and play will help them explore their gifts, talents and abilities.



This graded choir program meets on Wednesday nights through out the school year. Each choir presents two programs a year, Christmas and spring. For the older children we offer a Christmas Show Choir. This group presents a fully staged musical, complete with music, drama, dancing and set design. All choirs sing in the morning Sanctuary Services through out the school year and other church and community events.

Fine Arts Day School:

The Fine Arts Day School is open to pre-school children. Classes meet Mondays from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The Fine Arts curriculum is designed specifically for our preschool-aged children and provides an ideal environment for children to express themselves creatively.

The morning is divided into two sections: instruction in art and music. In art, children will refine and develop skills in drawing, painting, color/number/shape recognition, creative problem solving and viewing and critiquing artwork. The art section is taught by a certified Visual Arts instructor. The music curriculum is designed by Kindermusik and is taught by a certified Kindermusik instructor.

We follow the McEachern Preschool/Kindergarten calendar. The Fine Arts Day School is open to preschoolers who are three to five years of age (as of Sept. 1st). All children must be completely potty trained.



Kindermusik:

Children explore the world through games and interactive songs that foster self-expression and creativity. Tapping out rhythms on sticks, shaking jingle bells, moving, dancing and singing are all part of your child's activities in Kindermusik. For ages infant—7 years old.
