Sanctuary Choir

Our Sanctuary Choir leads our worship each Sunday morning for the 9:30 and 11:00 services. This choir is open to adults who feel a call to serve God through the musical gifts He has give them. The choir sings a wide variety of hymns that reflect our heritage as well as more contemporary music. This group also presents several special programs throughout the year and sings for many community events. They meet on Wednesday evenings at 7:30 pm in the Sanctuary. If you are interested in becoming a part of the Sanctuary Choir, you are welcome to join at any time during the year.

Ladies' Ensemble

Comprised of ladies from the Sanctuary Choir, this group meets on Wednesday evenings at 7:00pm in the Sanctuary. They sing periodically in Sunday services as well as for special events.

Men's Ensemble

Men from the Sanctuary Choir meet at 7:00 pm on Wednesday evenings in the East Room to work on music specifically written for men's voices. This group is active in singing at Sunday services as well as other church and community activities.

Chancel Ensemble

This group of mixed voices practice on Wednesday evenings at 6:30 pm in the Sanctuary. They sing on the second Sunday of the month for the 8:15 am service as well as other services held at the church and community activities.

Sanctuary Orchestra

These musicians (high school and up) play on select Sundays each month as well as for other special occasions. Rehearsal times vary.

Ladies' Handbells

This group meets on Wednesday evenings at 6:30 pm in Room F114. They play a 4-octave set of handbells and chimes and often play on Sunday mornings and community events. Membership is open as space is available.

Youth Handbells

The Youth Handbell choir meets to learn and practice handbells. It is open to students in grades 7-12 and they practice on Wednesday afternoons at 4:30. The group tours with the youth choir and plays occasionally for morning services.

Children's Choirs

The Graded Choir Ministry provides children ages 3 through 5th grade with the opportunity to grow spiritually and musically. All music is chosen with the goal of leading children to a growing faith in Jesus Christ. The music they sing and play will help them explore their gifts, talents and abilities. All choirs meet on Wednesday evenings. There is a children's choir singing every Sunday in the morning services through the school year.

New Creation Youth Choir

Young people in grades 6 through 12 sing in the New Creation Youth Choir. This choir rehearses on Sundays from 4:30 until 5:45 in the Chapel. There are several ensemble groups in the choir. Their practice times vary according to their upcoming events. The Youth Choir tours twice a year and sings for the morning services several times throughout the year.
